## **RESOLUTION 2022-01**

## A RESOLUTION REQUESTING DISTRIBUTION OF BRIDGE AND ROAD SAFETY AND ACCOUNTABILITY PROGRAM FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Bridge and Road Safety and Accountability Account created by HB 473 requires the Montana Department of Transportation to allocate accrued funds to cities, towns, counties, and consolidated city-county governments for construction, reconstruction, maintenance, and repair of rural roads, city or town streets and alleys, bridges, or roads and streets that the city, town, county, or consolidated city-county government has the responsibility to maintain; and,

WHEREAS, a city, town, county, or consolidated city-county government that requests funds under the Bridge and Road Safety and Accountability Account must match each \$20 requested with \$1 of local government matching funds; and,

WHEREAS, a city, town, county, or consolidated city-county government requesting distribution of allocated funds may make such a request to the Department of Transportation between March 1 and November 1 of the year the funds were allocated; and,

WHEREAS, a description of the projects to be funded (or the money used to match federal funds) are detailed below and,

**WHEREAS**, the local match for the allocated funds has been budgeted from General Fund and Capital Improvements.

## THEREFORE, NOW BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The Town of Twin Bridges requests distribution of its share of the allocated Bridge and Road Safety and Accountability funds to be used for the purchase of materials (gravel out of Horse Creek) to repair Madison Street and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue after the construction of the Stormdrain system is completed. Cost of materials and repairs will be \$31,050. Construction will consist of reapplying material to build the road back (maintenance) by replacing material that has worn away from the road because of weather, grading, vehicles, etc.
- 2. That Kristi Millhouse, the Town Clerk/Treasurer of the Town of Twin Bridges is hereby empowered and authorized to execute such further documents as may be necessary to facilitate the distribution of said funds.
